Drug Endangered Children are part of a very large and growing population of children whose lives have been seriously and negatively impacted by dangerous drugs. Thousands of these children across our nation go unnoticed and do not receive the necessary care and treatment to heal from these abusive environments. If ignored and left unmonitored, these children continue to be victims caught in a cycle and subculture of drug abuse with no opportunity for intervention. In an effort to change our response, professionals from multi-disciplines across the nation came together and developed an effective campaign to educate communities that wanted to address this problem. While the program does an effective job of raising awareness, it was not by nature designed to provide continued resources, technical assistance and continuing dialogue and support to sustain the DEC efforts. This year's conference will focus on building a framework necessary to provide sustainability for the Drug Endangered Children initiatives at the national, state and local level.
